

Quilt Show Acquisitions Information

The Acquisitions Committee for the "Quilts in the Mill 2010" Quilt Show is now soliciting quilts. We strongly encourage all members to submit quilts, regardless of pattern or level of difficulty. These quilts are for the community to enjoy and are not judged! The only stipulation for entering a quilt is that it has not been in a previous Courthouse Quilters show and that it was made by or owned by a current member.

Acquisition forms should be submitted for each quilt that you would like to have hung in the show. We will accept completed forms beginning any time after the June meeting. The deadline for submitting the completed forms is the September 12th Guild meeting. Your quilt does not have to be completed to submit the form, but it must be completed to hang in the show! 1. Enter as many items as you want, but one item per Acquisition Form. A value must be stated on the form for insurance purposes. Security will be arranged for the safety of your quilts.
2. Any forms received after the September Guild meeting, cannot be accepted in order to allow time for the programs to be printed.
3. A 3 inch by 5 inch photograph should accompany your form, with the quilt maker in the picture. This is necessary for insurance purposes. There will be a photographer at the July, August and September guild meetings to take pictures of your quilts if you would prefer to do that.
4. On the back of each quilt there should be a label with your name and phone number. Attach a 4" sleeve on top of the quilt for hanging. Sleeves must be sewn on! Sleeve directions will be in the newsletter. The quilt must be brought in a cloth bag that is also labeled with your name and phone number.
5. Quilts are to be delivered to the Darcy Lodge, our meeting place, on Rt. 513 in Frenchtown, between the hours of 9 am and 7 pm on Tuesday, September 28. If you need to make alternate arrangements, contact Janet Silliman.
6. Quilts are to be picked up on Sunday, October 3, at the Mill, between 6:00 and 7:00 pm. The show closes at 5:00 pm and no one will be allowed into the Mill until all the quilts are taken down and organized. Any quilts not picked up will be available from Janet Silliman or at the next guild meeting. Security after the show cannot be guaranteed. Your copy of the signed acquisition form is needed to receive your quilt. You may pick up another person's quilt if you have their form.

We have a reputation for having great quilt shows, so it would be wonderful having as many members participate as possible so we can have another show of which to be proud!
